REFLECTION FROM OUR MINISTER

Dear Friends,

This Monday [18th] is the feast of St Luke the Evangelist. He is so special in many ways. He is the only gentile to have written books of the Bible and has accompanied another great writer, St Paul the apostle. Besides being an evangelist and a physician, he had several other gifts. Legends have it that he was a painter, lacemaker and the list of his skills goes on and on, that is why he is the patron saint of doctors, artists, painters, lacemakers, goldsmiths and interestingly, bachelors, bookbinders and butchers!

So much about his skills, but we as Christians rejoice in God for Luke's presentation of his work in Luke & Acts. So much significance is given for the work of the Holy Spirit in both books. The gospel records the presence of the Holy Spirit at the birth, baptism and temptation of Jesus Christ. The canticles we use very often - the Benedictus (the Song of Zechariah), the Nunc Dimittis (the Song of Simeon) and the Magnificat (the Song of Mary) are songs of these godly people who were filled with the Holy Spirit.

In Acts, the work of the Holy Spirit is recorded in the way the Christian faith took roots in the Roman empire. From the day of Pentecost, the disciples and all believers were empowered to proclaim the gospel and live and work as strong witnesses for Christ, as seen in the lives of Stephen, Paul and Barnabas. The newly found faith in Christ just among a few Jews, soon spread among the gentiles with gospel teaching and spirit-filled baptism.

It is naturally assumed that Luke used his medical skills and cared for Paul when he was severely beaten and stoned. It is customary that on the Feast of St. Luke, we give thanks for the gift of doctors, nurses and all our medical services.
